- B. Review and Approve proposed CSIP Addendum based upon increased Teacher and Student Success Act (TSSA) (7:10)
  - a. Committee discussed that the estimated funds coming to Park Lane through TSSA funding later this summer will be used to hire additional aides or provide more hours for our current aides. We would also like to use some of the funding to make our part time position for our Behavior Assistant into a full time/benefited position. Additional funds will be used for teacher stipends in accordance with the TSSA stipend point distribution. Stipend monies will be used in conjunction with the CSIP academic goal for teachers who tutor students or support the goals during off-contract hours.
