A. Safety Concerns (7:00)

Nathan Adams volunteered to see if we can get a sign out on the south side that says something similar to, "No Parking between 8:00-8:30 and 3:00-3:30 Monday-Friday"

Morning garbage pickup when kids are walking into school: Parents have noticed that garbage and delivery trucks are in the parking lot while students are coming to school.
